To help empower our mission and ministry together, we also have an ambitious goal of raising \$200,000. Some of these funds will allow us to build upon our presence and outreach in our local community. Another portion of our money will connect us to the larger church, as we join the Metropolitan Washington DC Synod's "New Connections". The largest portion of our goal is to refresh and renew our facility in order to enhance our mission and outreach to all God's people. The first part of the capital campaign has gone extremely well. We have nearly reached our pledge goal. Now is the time to finish the task and complete our goal as we look forward to growing our community of grace.

Our Goal: \$200,000

- "Building on the Best", we plan to extend and revitalize Holy Cross
- We aspire to grow our congregation: welcome 48 new members over the next three years
- We aspire to attract families and youth, and strengthen relationships among our members
- We aspire to enhance our commitment to serve the larger family of God

Our commitments, prayer and funds will be apportioned as follows:

\$35,000 - Building On Our Evangelical Mission:

- Strengthen community connections, through awareness: Herndon Festival, Sterlingfest
- Foster fun-filled community activities, to spread our message, such as 'Beer & Carols' events
- Support Community Youth by Partnership with Herndon Middle School & The Neighborhood Resource Center
- Create Service Opportunities for children & youth, in worship and the community

\$14,000 - Building the Broader Church:

Join with congregations of the Metropolitan Washington DC Synod, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, so that others may know the fullness of life in Jesus Christ



- Contribute to the Synod New Connections campaign, applying resources for developing, training, coaching, with the goal of 3000 new members over three years
- Apply New Connections ideas and resources to build connections with 48 new people / members at Holy Cross

\$151,000 – Building on our Facilities:

- Update our facilities to be welcoming and inviting for families and community members
- Renovate the antiquated restrooms adjacent to the Fellowship Hall
- Replace the roof in the administrative wing
- Install new flooring in the Fellowship Hall
- Upgrade Technology for the offices, Fellowship Hall and classroom spaces

Giving Opportunities

In order to reach or Capital Campaign goal, gifts of all sizes are needed, from the largest leadership gifts, to the precious coins from our children. We need many gifts to fulfil our dream of upgrading our ministry facilities, and more effectively reaching out into our community.

Please prayerfully consider how your family is called to respond to this opportunity, given your own financial blessings.

The Campaign's commitment period is 3 years (156 weeks). A pledge of support is not a legally binding contract, but a statement of intent.

- Stocks, Bonds and Mutual Fund Shares
- Donating appreciated securities is one of the easiest ways to support Holy Cross's mission while you take advantage of significant tax savings (You may claim full fair market value of the securities as a charitable deduction on your personal tax return. Because you are donating, rather than selling the securities, you do not report or pay capital gains tax on their appreciation, maximizing your gift while minimizing your taxes.)
